

## Essay Submission Policy

The Michigan State Journal of History gladly accepts submissions of essays written by Michigan State undergraduates of any major. Submissions can be of interest in a wide range of areas, but all should relate to history or historiography. Submissions that are accepted will be expected to be of professional standard and are expected to make a significant statement or interpretation to the academic debate surrounding the topic. Submissions that have been published previously or that are being considered for publication elsewhere will not be considered by this organization.

All students are encouraged to submit their research to: MichiganStateJournalofHistory@gmail.com. Students are welcome to submit papers from previous semesters. Requirements minimally include:

- Chicago Style format
- Footnotes
- A highly recommended page limit of 10-20 pages
- A bibliography with primary and secondary sources separated
- 12 point, Times New Roman font
- Doubled spaced
- 1 inch margins
- No identifying marks to ensure confidentiality
- Pagination on the bottom right corner
- Submitted as a Word document
- Abstract of 100 words or less

Authors are also required to include the class and professor the work was written for (if applicable) and any other faculty members or graduate students that may have a conflict of interest in reviewing the work. Additional requirements and exact deadlines for submissions will be announced in Fall 2016.
