C. Three courses (9 credits) in History at the 300 and/or 400 level focused on one of the following geographic areas: Africa, Asia, Europe, Latin America:

D. Two courses (6 credits) in History at the 300 and/or 400 level focused on an area of the world other than the one chosen in item C above.

E. One senior seminar chosen from HST 481, 482, 483, 484, 485, 486, 487, 488 (3 credits):

This course must be related to the area of historical concentration chosen in item C above. The completion of this requirement satisfies the department's capstone course requirement. Credits in HST 490 and HST 499H may not be used to fulfill this requirement.

F. One experiential learning course (3 credits), which may be fulfilled by a HST course taken on a Study Abroad or Study Away program, an internship with a historical focus (HST 493), or an additional senior seminar (HST 48x) focused on any area of the world and topic.

G. An **Area Studies minor** appropriate to the geographical area of concentration chosen in item C above. History courses taken in the Area Studies minor may count towards the major as well as the minor.

H. **Language requirement:** Demonstration of a second-year competency in a foreign language relevant to the geographical area of concentration chosen in item C above. This requirement may be fulfilled by examination, by taking courses up to and including the second semester of the second year of study of the language, or by being a native speaker of the language.
